

ITEMS FOR PUPPY PACKETS GIVEN BY BREEDERS

(A list of items that can be given to the new puppy/doggy Owners)

- 🐾 Booklet on how to care for & train your AKK, puppy care and what to expect from a puppy.
 - There is an AKK Puppy Care Guide posted under Education www.akkaoa.org
- 🐾 Breed Standards from UKC Web Site.
- 🐾 The puppy's health record of when wormed and shots, etc. have been given, info on when his/her first nail clipping, how much they weighed each week, when eyes opened, when started walking, the future vaccination schedule, and a pamphlet on first aid.
- 🐾 Copies of the States law on puppy sales.
- 🐾 Pet Health Record for new owners to record future shots, worming, other health/medical procedures, etc.
- 🐾 Vet Check Certificate and Health guarantee
- 🐾 Microchip registration form
- 🐾 Signed Contract
- 🐾 Puppy papers (copy) pending arrival of actual certificate from UKC and a 5 generation pedigree.
- 🐾 Adult Exam Form, also explaining the need for blood work and what blood work.
- 🐾 AKKAOA and UAKKA membership application forms
- 🐾 AKK pamphlet by Lenor Lynas
- 🐾 Contact information for the Chair(s) of Health and Medical Research
- 🐾 Papers (copies) on dog training handed out at dog classes.
- 🐾 CD with all their puppy pictures and photos of their parents.
- 🐾 Breeders Vet's Name and Number and Breeder's business card, or contact info.
- 🐾 Two or three toys
- 🐾 Blanket or stuffed animal with scent from Mom and littermates.
- 🐾 Collar
- 🐾 Food that they have been eating
- 🐾 Package of Cesar Select Dinners
- 🐾 Little jar of liver baby food
- 🐾 A few treats to chew on
- 🐾 A chew bone
- 🐾 Lyme disease info
- 🐾 Heartgard Plus (also stressing to the new owners how important it is to keep up on it monthly)
- 🐾 Frontline Plus
- 🐾 Coupons

If owners are traveling by car to pick up puppy, send with them a wet wash cloth in a baggy and some paper towels, for any accidents that may happen along the way.

Ship by Air:

- 🐾 info on how the owner is to contact the airport to find out when to pick up puppy
- 🐾 info about ice being in the crate, rather than water, info about what is attached to the crate etc.

What they should take to the airport with them like:

- 🐾 a pair of scissors or knife to remove what is taped on top of the crate
- 🐾 a wet wash cloth and paper towels (just in case).

When they leave, they have/are:

- 🐾 Shots and all worming up-to-date
- 🐾 Micro chipped
- 🐾 Dew Claws removed
- 🐾 Paper trained and crate trained.
